

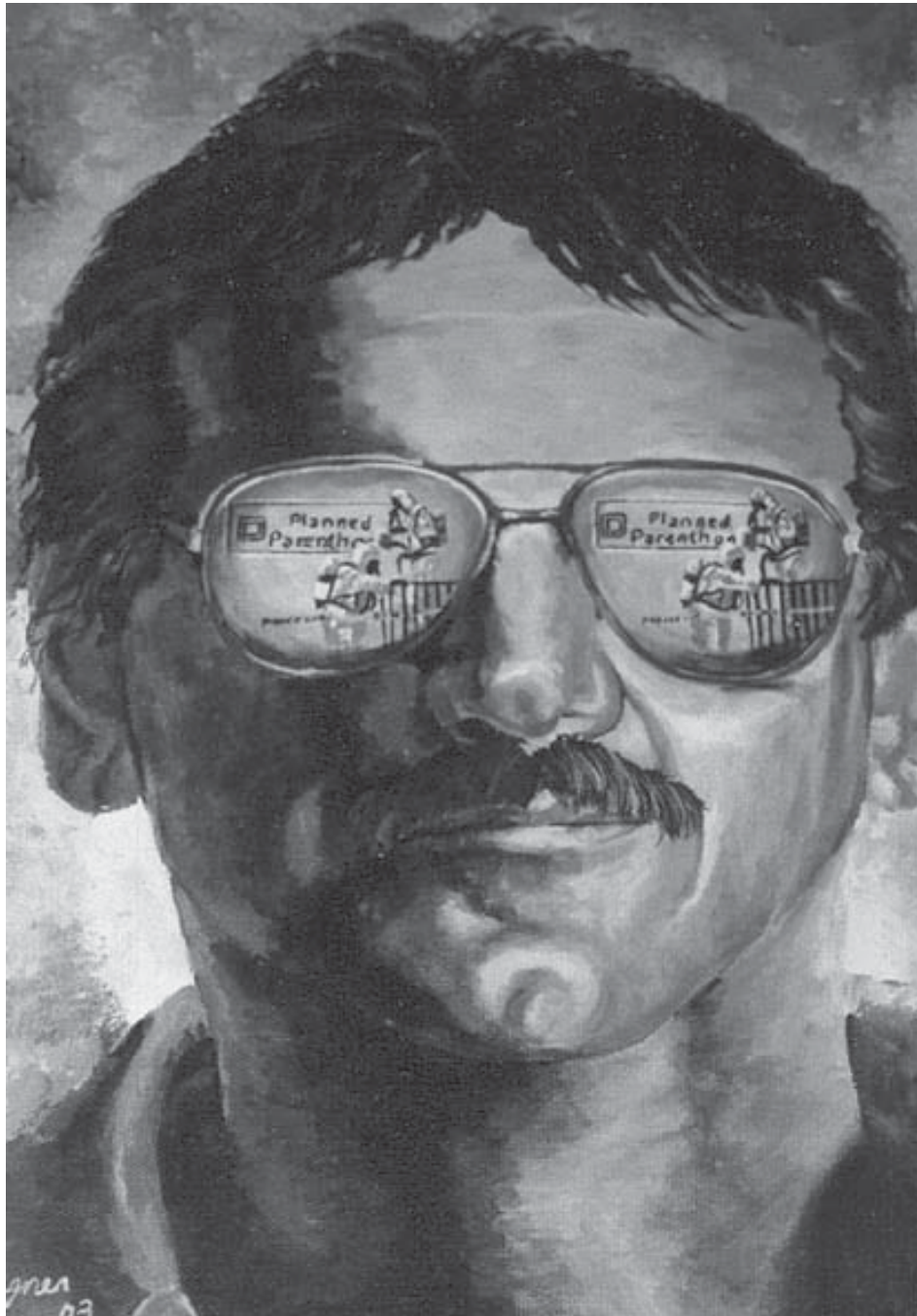
# Clay Waagner: AT WAR With Legalized Abortion

*Justice would inevitably see to it that the nation which declared war on God and which has legalized the slaughter of His children would one day wake up and realize that the warfare which was hidden for so long in the blood soaked rooms of abortion "clinics" has now surfaced on the city streets and in the homes of every person in the United States of America. Dear brother and sister,

When I began my war to protect the preborn murdered by abortion, I believed I was alone against having a trial in Buffalo. I don't know what caused them. After my arrest a few in the anti-abortion movement found me and embraced me for my efforts. It was a great comfort to know that others believed as I did and supported my actions. After my escape it was always in my mind that I was not alone. That others agreed with what I was doing and were praying for me gave me great comfort which warmed me through some very difficult moments and was a major factor in my being able to close so many abortion mills. Today I wonder if I was comforted by a lie. The lack of support I have received in preparing for this most important trial makes me question the depth and commitment of the antiabortion movement to this cause which we all voice so loudly.



Much has been said about Jim Kopp's not having an idea it was the fault of the very group who claims to agree with his actions. Jim had the courage to do something I could not, to pull the trigger on a baby murderer, but he did not have the heart to face a public trial without the support of his peers.

I understand what Jim has gone through. Two supporters visited my last trial. Six of you have written to encourage me, and a few have attempted to locate the trial data I need. Those precious few I greatly appreciate, but the rest of you have become an anchor around my neck. I have come to despise those of you who offer your mouth in opposition to the mass murder of innocent preborn children,

preborn children, but are too complacent and lazy to lift a finger in their defense. I am equally disgusted with those of you who once fought hard, but are now warmed by past victories. The babies you saved yesterday are grateful, but your past valor means nothing to the 4,000 babies who will die in abortion mills today.

I am concerned about the future of this noble cause. We are a fruit rotting on the vine, but are unaware of our status. We think we are strong, but we are not. Even our enemies overestimate our strength. But I have learned the truth in your response to my request for research help. For a few fleeting moments I considered giving in and not fighting at trial. This was not to make my life easier, which it would, but to protect our cause. This trial represents the largest scale attack against the abortion industry in its 30 year history, so the nation's media is sure to show up in force. When two supporters show up the real story will become the lack of support I received. Rightly so. I believe Jim Kopp waived his trial for just this reason: to save our group the embarrassment of being exposed as the toothless tiger that we are. Jim did not want to show the world just how inane and shallow we have become.

After much prayer and consideration I have decided to continue the fight. In considering pulling out to protect the cause, I nearly fell victim to the same sickness that has critically infected the pro-life movement. I nearly placed the protection of the cause ahead of what is needed to protect the babies. The Babies! Remember them? The reason for the cause is the babies!

I will fight for the preborn with all of my ability at this trial. If I must stand alone then so be it. If we as a group are exposed as a sorry lot of armchair warriors who "kill and eat their own", then so be it. I do love you who have stood up for the preborn, but it is not you that I fight for. I fight for the innocent preborn who are murdered under the banner of "Choice". I will always protect the individual with my silence, but I will not waiver from the fight for the babies to protect our group from bad PR. It is my belief that God would rather you (the anti-abortion movement) were exposed in your complacency than to allow you to pretend you were doing His will when you are not.

The pro-abortionist say the issue is a matter of choice. It is about choice for us as well.

We can stand up and fight for the millions of innocent who are murdered in our midst, or we can choose to do nothing more than mouth our opposition. My choice has been well established.

I will always fight.

Prison has not stopped my fight to save the pre-born children from murder by abortion, but it has forced me to change my tactics. As part of these new tactics I have completed a book

which chronicles my most successful campaign against legalized abortion.' "Fighting The American Holocaust" will be available through Virginia Dare Press (my wife's company) in about a month. I have also taken advantage of one of the prison's programs and learned to paint. The painting is a self-portrait called "Small Victories." Art can be a powerful medium to promote a cause if used properly...I would encourage pro-life artists everywhere to use their talents as a weapon to fight for the pre-born.

Today my goals are the same as they were when I was a "Fugitive Terrorist." I am still doing everything within my ability to fight the holocaust that we call abortion. To this end I can only use my pen, my paint brush, and my voice. At the upcoming trial in Philadelphia I plan to use my voice as powerfully as possible. The most powerful thing I could do in that trial is to win and have a federal jury find my actions justified. Such a verdict would send a powerful message to this nation. To this end I need your support.

I ask for something you can give. I ask for your prayer support. What I am now attempting is so difficult as to be considered impossible. But I know that in Christ Jesus all things are possible. I also know the power of prayer...Please pray for me as I prepare for this trial and as I attempt to enlighten others through my art.

I would also encourage you to remember the othes imprisoned for fighting to save the pre-born. Prison can be a dark and lonely void. Those who are there very much need to know that they are loved and supported.

You have formed your opinion on the evil of abortion, but have you made your choice to fight? Have you really chosen which side you are on? The lives of millions of God's precious children hang in the balance.
