Judge Orders God To Break Up Into Smaller Deities

WASHINGTON, DC—Calling the theological giant's stranglehold on the religion industry "blatantly anti-competitive," a U.S. district judge ruled Monday that God is in violation of anti-monopoly laws and ordered Him to be broken up into several less powerful deities.

"The evidence introduced in this trial has convinced me that the deity known as God has willfully and actively thwarted competition from other deities and demigods, promoting His worship with such unfair scare tactics as threatening non-believers with eternal damnation," wrote District Judge Charles Elliot Schofield in his decision. "In the process, He has carved out for Himself an illegal monotheopoly."

The suit, brought against God by the Justice Department on behalf of a coalition of "lesser deities" and polytheistic mortals, alleged that He violated antitrust laws by claiming in the Holy Bible that He was the sole creator of the universe, and by strictly prohibiting the worship of what He termed "false idols."

In compliance with Monday's decision, God must:

- Divest all holdings in churches, synagogues, and mosques
- Cede miracle-performing services to local deities
- Cease and desist strongarm tactic of smiting nonbelievers
- Allow competition from pagan gods and animistic spirits

What this means for worshippers:

- Quicker prayer-response time
- Likely reduction in yearly tithes and tributes
- Wider selection of specialized deities
- No reprisals for false-idol worship

The defendant

This news article taken from a recent issue of the online humor magazine "The Onion," elicits an emotion similar to humor because the parody spotlights the shocking paradox between the way we know things are supposed to be and the way things are becoming.

To show how close reality has come to the spoof above, note what happened on May 23, 2003 in Colorado where a judge threw out a convicted killer's death sentence, saying the jury improperly relied on the Bible to reach its decision.

The Associated Press reported that Judge John Vigil explained his decision this way, "The death penalty, however, must be imposed in a constitutional manner ... Jury resort to biblical code has no place in a constitutional death penalty proceeding."

Some Christian Pastors agree. The Rev.

"God clearly commands that there shall be no other gods before Him, and He frequently

Barry Lynn, director of Americans United for Separation of Church and State, said that in the secular legal system, juries should consult the law, not the Bible.

"Juries must obey the instructions of the judge, not the interpretations of any holy Scripture," he said.

Having eradicated prayer and any mention of God and America's Christian heritage from our schools and public life, we the people are now constructing a new religion, and that new religion already rules the federal government of the USA as well as we the people who are subject to the federal government.

On the surface this new religion seems designed to cater to the generic Monotheistic religions (Judaism, Islam, and Christianity). President Bush's inauguration speech was dedicated to "churches, synagogues and mosques." The actual religion that is being constructed by the federal government has created a new model of god, a model of a god who allows anyone to believe anything they want to believe about God EXCEPT that He is One God and will destroy anyone who refuses to obey Him. People who believe in THAT God are being labeled as hatemongers and terrorists and are well on their way to being outcasts in the economy of this nation, and are very likely to end up as actual outlaws before too long.

What it Takes To Go To War With The Real God

¹And God spake all these words, saying, ²I am the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. ³Thou shalt have no other gods before me. ⁴Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: ⁵Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; ⁶And showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

The point is clear: Violate the Commandment above and you are at war with God; He will kill you and your children and your children's children's children's children until the end of time.

Anyone with eyes to see can see that the federal government of the USA has made it policy to destroy the First Commandment of God.

Great confusion is created when the institution that God created to be the source of justice and the establishment of His law on earth is usurped and turned against God. Christians especially tend to be lummoxed more than most when such desecration occurs because they are normally trained to be the willing and loyal servants of government authority.

In times like this we look for a teacher to help us understand our duty. Throughout the history of Christendom no teacher has summarized the duty of a loyal disciple of the Lord Jesus Christ than John Calvin. He concluded his **Institutes of the Christian Religion** with these words,

32. Obedience to man must not become disobedience to God

But in that obedience which we hold to be due to the commands of rulers, we must always make the exception, nay, must be particularly careful that it is not incompatible with obedience to Him to whose will the wishes of all kings should be subject, to whose decrees their commands must yield, to whose majesty their sceptres must bow. And, indeed, how preposterous were it, in pleasing men, to incur the offence of Him for whose sake you obey men! The Lord, therefore, is King of kings. When he opens his sacred mouth, he alone is to be heard, instead of all and above all. We are subject to the men who rule over us, but subject only in the Lord. If they command any thing against Him, let us not pay the least regard to it, nor be moved by all the dignity which they possess as magistrates - a dignity to which, no injury is done when it is subordinated to the special and truly supreme power of God. On this ground Daniel denies that he had sinned in any respect against the king when he refused to obey his impious decree, (Dan. 6: 22,) because the king had exceeded his limits, and not only been injurious to men, but, by raising his horn against God, had virtually abrogated his own power. On the other hand, the Israelites are condemned for having too readily obeyed the impious edict of the king. For, when Jeroboam made the golden calf, they forsook the temple of God, and, in submissiveness to him, revolted to new superstitions, (1 Kings 12: 28.) With the same facility posterity had bowed before the decrees of their kings. For this they are severely upbraided by the Prophet, (Hosea 5: 11.) So far is the praise of modesty from being due to that pretence by which flattering courtiers cloak themselves, and deceive the simple, when they deny the lawfulness of declining any thing imposed by their kings, as if the Lord had resigned his own rights to mortals by appointing them to rule over their fellows or as if earthly power were diminished when it is subjected to its author, before whom even the principalities of heaven tremble as suppliants. I know the imminent peril to which subjects expose themselves by this firmness, kings being most indignant when they are condemned. As Solomon says, "The wrath of a king is as messengers of death," (Prov. 16: 14.) But since Peter, one of heaven's heralds, has published the edict, "We ought to obey God rather than men," (Acts 5: 29,) let us console ourselves with the thought, that we are rendering the obedience which the Lord requires when we endure anything rather than turn aside from piety. And that our courage may not fail, Paul stimulates us by the additional considerations (1 Cor. 7: 23,) that we were redeemed by Christ at the great price which our redemption cost him, in order that we might not yield a slavish obedience to the depraved wishes of men, far less do homage to their impiety.

Interestingly, recent Catholic Popes have mirrored the Protestant Calvin's points.

As Paul de Parrie pointed out in an earlier article in this issue, God has been at war for a long time but it was not always this way. In the beginning everything that God created was "very good" (Genesis 1:31) with no pain, no suffering, no death, and no sin. God's creation, which included everything in the universe except God Himself, was very good indeed. Because they were very good, God's creatures enjoyed full fellowship with God, experiencing God's unbridled love and infinite goodness from God's hand. The creatures created in His image, Adam and Eve, had access to the Tree of Life whose fruit provided eternal life, and nothing in all of creation need ever have suffered or died.



THE PUNISHMENT OF GOD

The idea that must divide monotheists throughout the world today centers on whether God will actually punish people in any way whatsoever.

Already a huge contingent of people who call themselves Christians and or Jews and or Muslims (the main three groups of monotheists) have committed themselves to a theology explaining why God should never be seen to be punishing people. This particular message is becoming the point of unity among the three heretofore different religions and promises to be the bridge that can result in some new monotheistic world consensus on "god."

I could find literally thousands of examples of Christian Pastors, writers and teachers to illustrate how monotheists are redefining God. But to precisely describe what I am talking about I will take for example, Rabbi Roderick Young, of Hebrew University, who tells us in his article "A Gay Perspective On Punishment And Disease" that, ""Those who stand on the sidewalks of life and declare that AIDS and other diseases are a punishment from God are...guilty of slandering the ill and of slandering God...[this slander] it is a plague which has no place within our communities. We are all made b'tselem Elohim, in the image of God. We only do justice to that image when we are merciful and compassionate, slow to anger, and abounding in kindness."

The Rabbi continued, "God is indeed present in AIDS, cancer, polio, in all diseases. For God is present in the way in which we respond to illness in others. When we visit the sick, or raise money to fight disease, then God is present. And when we are the ones who are sick, perhaps we will discern the face of God in a doctor, a nurse, a family member, a friend."

His point is that God never is to be seen to be the cause of disease, or pain, or punishment in any form whatsoever.

It is most instructive to examine how the Rabbi arrived at these conclusions. You can see his methodology in the beginning of the article when he said, "During festival days, one way in which our liturgy seeks to describe God is by taking a part of Exodus 34: 6-7 and inserting it into the Torah service: 'Adonai, Adonai, God merciful and compassionate, slow to anger, and abounding in kindness and faithfulness, extending kindness to a thousand generations, forgiving iniquity, transgression and sin, and granting pardon.' "

Then he says a most surprising thing. He explains, "The end of verse 7, which tells how the sins of the parents are visited upon the children, is deliberately

omitted. The message of the liturgy is clear—as Jews we must seek out the compassionate side of God and not the punitive one. Ours is not a God who gives people polio, cancer, or AIDS as punishment."

Did you get that? The Rabbi, in order to develop his analysis in a Scriptural context, was required to leave out a portion of Exodus 34:7, the portion that contained words that literally contradicted the point he had decided to teach. So he omitted the contradicting message from God's word and taught what he wanted to teach anyway.

People opposed to the God revealed in Holy Scripture have always made their first line of attack these words, "Oh, you can make the Bible say anything you want it to say."

And of course they are right...if you do with the Bible what the Rabbi did. All it takes to make the Bible say anything you want it to say is delete those passages that say things contrary to what you want to say.

But unfortunately for all us people on earth today, when you leave all the words in place in the Bible and you interpret those words using the same principles of interpretation we apply to the New York Times, it becomes clear that the Bible clearly teaches that God punishes people.

Genesis 3:24 "So he drove out the man; and he placed at the east of the garden of Eden Cherubims, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to keep the way of the tree of life.

If you believe the Bible tells a true story, and you think about it for awhile, you might agree that the words above are some of the saddest ever written. They are the saddest because the words tell how it came to be that you and I and our children and our children's children must face and be defeated by death.

And the words seem to be clear: God drove out the man. Man did not leave the garden of his own "free will." From the place of perfect peace, and of perfect comfort, from the place of eternal life (after all the Tree of Life was in the Garden), God drove out the man.

But God did not stop there. He placed guards, and He placed a flaming sword. And they were there to prevent man from having access to the tree of life.

For those who believe the Garden of Eden story is a true account of God and man, what happened to Grandfather Adam and Grandmother Eve has got

to be seen to be the worst thing that has ever happened to our family in the history of the world.

And if the clear words of Holy Scripture can be believed, God did it. And He meant to do it. He meant to cut our family off so we would have to die.

How would Mr. Rogers react if his wife, child or grandchild died and at the funeral a pompous idiot told him that his loved one died because they had sinned against God. People who smoke, die of lung cancer; who overeat, die of heart disease. I am sure that he and his loved ones are totally without sin or God will kill them as he does everyone else. What a hateful God."

WHO DOES HE THINK HE IS?

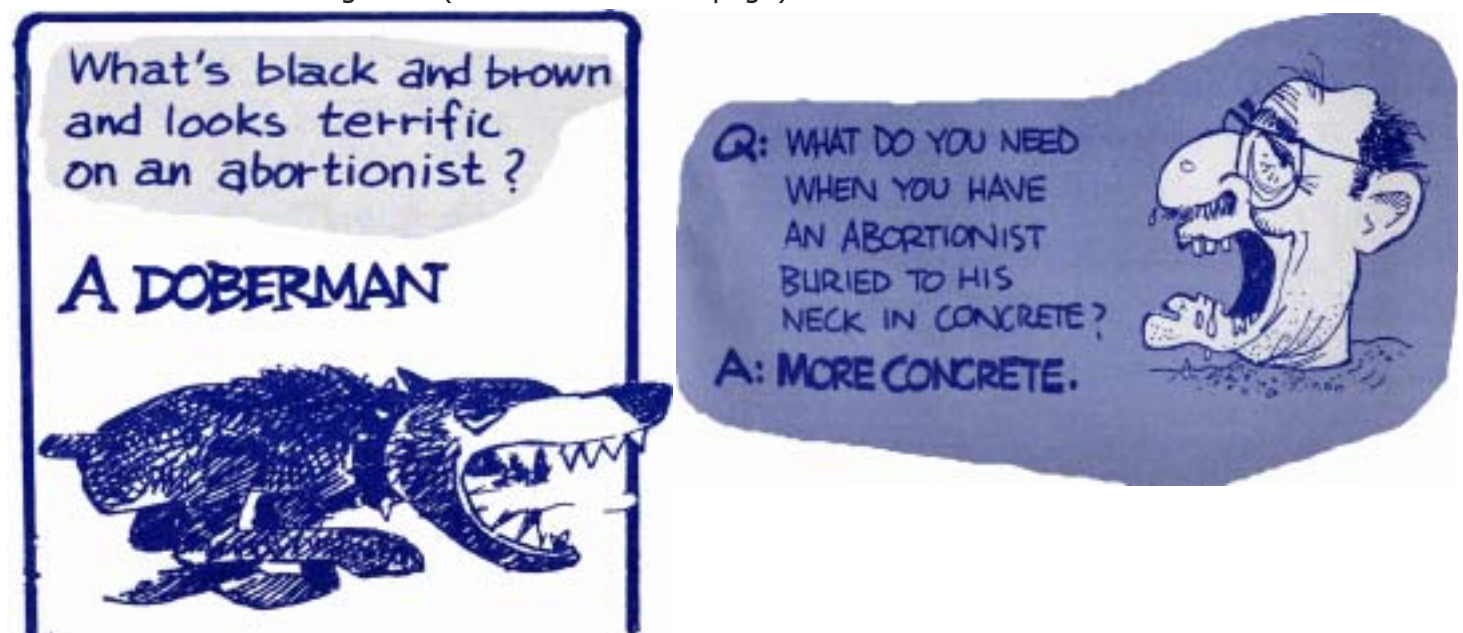
I understand something about the God the Bible talks about that makes it possible for me to love the God revealed in every letter and syllable of the Bible. But I understand how the God of the Bible must look to those outside Christ Jesus. There is no doubt those people, if they actually read what the Bible says about God, must be tempted to literally hate Him because He obviously is, as the man said, "a hateful God."

Why is He hateful? Because the God of the Bible, for no other reason than our refusing to obey Him and treat Him like He wants to be treated, intends to kill us all. Not only that, but He is actually doing it! As Rabbi Bob Dylan said before the silver lined his bed, "Those who are not busy being born are busy dying."
