

ARE YOU READY YET FOR A FRESH VISION THAT CAN ABOLISH LEGALIZED ABORTION?

Thirty years of trying and the best we can do is make the butchers poke the babies' heads back inside their mother's vagina before the baby's head is cut off and it's body's contents drained into a container marked "Medical Waste."

Legislation like the Partial Birth Abortion bills has been tried and, even when it is successfully passed, as the preceding article demonstrates, has done nothing to abolish legalized abortion. In fact, in many cases the legislation that is passed actually makes it more likely that more death will occur.

For instance, as Dennis Green points out in the preceding article, not one less baby will be aborted after the PBA ban passes. The bill does nothing to change the fact that babies can be aborted at any time. Passage of PBA ban merely means the baby being butchered cannot now extend outside the mother's birth canal.

In a grim paradox like many that have plagued every step of the "pro-life movement," passage of the Partial Birth Abortion ban will mean a far greater danger to the mother than presently exists when Partial Birth Abortion procedures are employed. Whereas before, with the baby fully in view, the abortionist could simply cut off the baby's leg or the baby's head--depending on the type of delivery--and drain the baby down to an empty sack of human tissue, and thereby easily extricate the baby's corpse from the mother's birth canal with little risk to the mother. But with passage of PBA ban, no portion of the baby can protrude. The virtually full term baby must be

dismembered with the abortion working totally blind inside the mother. Hundreds of first and second trimester aborting mothers have already been killed under those circumstances when an abortionist created an "oops" with a snipped bowel here and there. The

PBA ban will undoubtedly add to those numbers with slipping scalpels stabbing both mother and baby.

There is a pattern visible here if we would but see it. Virtually all the things that have been tried by the "pro-life movement" that were designed to arrest legalized abortion have, at least in some very significant ways, had precisely the opposite effect. The paradox is complete when we realize that the very "pro-lifers" who moan the most about the "poor mothers" who are "damaged" by abortion are the very people who are setting the "poor mothers" up for another round of wholesale slaughter.

Are you beginning to see how the "pro-life movement" instead of being helpful to abortion abolition has played a key role in its perpetuation?

Reread the words of Annie Prolifer. She catalogs a litany of effects created by the actions of the Reverend Paul Hill, and much of what she said clearly contains at least

the seeds of truth. His actions did make it more problematic to call abortion murder and abortionists murderers.

What Annie Prolifer said about Rev. Hill can just as easily be said about the tactics of Operation Rescue...and has been said. Annie and Arnold Prolifers have said for years that "non-violent civil disobedience" led directly to the passage of the Freedom of Access to

Clinic Entrances Act of 1994, *a law that drastically curtailed the presense of the pro-life community at the abortion clinics in this nation* While many have tried to blame this law on the actions of the assassins and bombers, the language of the law makes it clear those who obstructed access to the clinics in "non-violent" ways were some of the primary targets of the legislation.

Now it is commonplace to hear Annie Prolifer griping about all the people who hold up pictures of dead babies in public places.

The point is this: it is always going to be possible to find negative and counter productive aspects in any and every tactic that is utilized to try to abolish legalized abortion. Whereas it might be possible to effectuate a "clean" deterrence of abortion when an expectant mother is persuaded to carry to term, it is literally impossible to bring about the abolition of legalized abortion without getting our jerseys very dirty indeed.

Why? Because the abolition of legalized abortion, unlike the private decision of an expectant mother to carry her baby to term, is a *corporate decision that will involve the wills, intentions, desires and goals of millions of people. Think about it: millions of those people have invested their entire reputation, honor, fortune and livelihood on perpetuating legalized abortion. Those people are going to look at anything that has the slightest possibility of actually abolishing legalized abortion and they are going to find a huge list of reasons to explain why that is not only a bad thing, it is the baddest thing that could possibly happen, perhaps in the history of the world.*

Given the fact that there are so many people who will always fight tooth and nail against any strategy that might abolish legalized abortion a good case can be made that the strategy that true abortion abolitionists should be quick to support is the strategy that everyone with a vested interest in the perpetuation of legalized abortion hates the most.

Who has a vested interest in perpetuating legalized abortion? The answer might surprise all except the most grizzled abortion abolitionists.

The usual suspects are easy to identify. Planned Parenthood, The Nation Federation of Abortionists, etc. all clearly depend for their livelihood on the perpetuation of legalized abortion. Were legalized abortion to be abolished, there's hardly an abortionist in the country that could find anywhere to practice their "medicine." And the bureaucratic hacks that populate the Planned Parenthood offices would be out of work as well.

There is another category of people who depend on the perpetuation of legalized abortion as well. For years I have been watching that category of people fight the strategy I have advocated to end legalized abortion and I have reached the point where I finally must publicly say that I think that category of people is just as unwilling to see the abolition of

legalized abortion as anyone in Planned Parenthood. There is only one distinction between the two groups: whereas Planned Parenthood will admit it is willing to do anything to prevent the abolition of legalized abortion, the group I am referring to now is equally committed to preventing the abolition of legalized abortion, yet will not admit it.

Who am I referring to? The thousands of professional employees of the Christian pro-life organizations and the Christian para-church organizations and Christian congregations who you will get a chance to see with your own eyes do everything in their power to prevent you from participating in the one strategy that is guaranteed to have the power to arrest legalized abortion in our lifetime.

That's right. I am accusing this generation of professional Christians of being the main obstacle to abolishing legalized abortion at this time in history. Not only am I accusing them, I have been given a way by God to show you that my accusations against them are true.

This issue of the Abortion Abolitionist spotlights a plan that has never been attempted since abortion was legalized. The plan is presently legal to implement. If the secession movement advocated here was seriously implemented by even a small minority of people in this nation the possibility exists that legalized abortion might be abolished. That much is true.

But watch and you will see that most of the professional pro-lifers in this nation will be doing everything in their power to prevent Christians from participating in the secession movement. Don't expect them to publicly make a show of their resistance. They will operate offstage in the pews and classrooms of most of the Christian churches of this nation and there they will do everything they can do to discourage people from participating in a secession movement with the power to abolish legalized abortion.

How can I make such an accusation?

They have already been doing it for years. For over a decade as I have tried to get people to understand the absolute necessity of a secession movement, I have watched as the very leaders who would normally be expected to be my allies--that is, if they were actually interested in seeing legalized abortion abolished--become the most effective agents resisting the strategy I advocated. Planned Parenthood did not have to spend a penny to resist The Creator's Rights Party, the leaders of the Christian pro-life movement did all their work for them.

I don't expect that to change until enough people begin to support the secession movement so that the rank and file of the abortion abolition movement begins to sense that we are actually creating a new resistance with the power, if implemented fully, to abolish legalized abortion. At such a time, the present leaders of the pro-life movement who have made it a policy to treat me as an enemy will slink away like the duplicitous enemy agents that they are.

Will you provide that support now? END
