

How The Constitution Party Confuses Christians

The people who are managing the Constitution Party sow confusion for two reasons: 1. they teach people the problem in this nation is a problem with the Constitution when actually the problem in this nation is a problem of idolatry: the federal government has lifted up an new national god idol to replace The Creator; 2. they act like they think there is something that can be done through the existing political system to arrest this idolatry when in fact it is only through threatening the destruction of the existing political system that the system itself might be returned to viability.

As several articles in this issue demonstrate, thirty years ago it was reasonable to believe that the present political system could arrest the desecration we see around us because it was reasonable to believe that God had a majority of people in this nation who were willing to insist that God's priorities be implemented by the federal government of the USA. But we have learned that the existing majority is willing to be the best paid peasants in history rather than be obedient servants of the King of kings. Today political leaders who still develop strategies based on the "godly majority" premise prove themselves to be either self-deceivers--in which case they certainly are not qualified to be responsible leaders--or either they are moles sent here by the enemy to confuse God's people so that Satan can continue to receive his daily ration of God's children unjustly slaughtered.

You can see what I am talking about if you will look. The Constitution party is running a candidate for President of the USA. Now, obviously, the man could not be elected without a majority.

Oops. I forgot we're now in that cloud cookoo land where the only majority that is required to elect the President of the United States of America is a majority on the Supreme Court of the USA.

And of course that is the point. All political power and legal power in the United States of America is now concentrated in the hands of the Supreme Court. In fact, if you had been around in 1973 and heard the very first pronouncements of the "wise" Christian leaders in this nation who were called upon to explain how God was going to restore His protection to His unborn children, you would have heard something like this: "Well, God will just have to raise up a Presidential candidate that we can support. When that President is elected, then that President will appoint justices to the Supreme Court who will overturn Roe v. Wade and restore rightful statutes that reflect God's justice and God's plan for government."

But that is not all the "wise" pro-life leaders said. (Do your homework and you will see that I am talking about James Dobson and James Kennedy and Jerry Falwell and Pat Robertson and any and all of the nationally known Bible-believing leaders of fundamental and/or conservative and/or evangelical Protestant Christianity who had made a name and a following for themselves in the 1970's). They were also quick to add, "Before we can expect to have a Christian President who can correct the Supreme Court, we must educate Christians about the horrors of legalized abortion."

From the beginning everyone in the pro-life movement assumed that the majority would want to outlaw abortion when the actual physical facts about legalized abortion became known. It was an article of faith in the pro-life movement from the beginning that, instead of being the "Silent Majority" that Jerry Falwell was so fond of talking about in the 70's, when enlightened by the pro-life leaders like James Dobson, the majority would stand up and let their voice be known in support of a President who would, one way or another, lead the overthrow of Roe v. Wade.

President Ronald Reagan: Willful Self-Deception or Simple Ignorance of the Facts?

It was during the Presidency of Ronald Reagan that the pro-life movement began to prove that it was capable of either willful self-deception or plain ignorance of historically unprecedented proportions.

In 1983, the "pro-life movement" stood monolithically united in support of President Ronald Reagan's reelection. Either the leaders of the "pro-life movement" willfully deceived themselves and their supporters or they simply ignored the fact that Ronald Reagan had never done one thing to actually impede "abortion rights" in the USA.

According to Lou Cannon in his book about Reagan entitled, *The Role of a Lifetime*, "Unfortunately there was more to Ronald Reagan than his Christian supporters seemed to understand. Before becoming President Ronald Reagan had been Governor of California. Early in his California governorship he had signed a permissive abortion bill that has resulted in more than a million abortions. Afterward, he inaccurately blamed this outcome on doctors, saying that they had deliberately misinterpreted the law."

Like all politicians, President Ronald Reagan had explanations for everything. But unfortunately for the millions of babies being butchered, his explanations often were so wrong as to be literally bizarre.

For a perfect example of the world class ignorance that has beset the "pro-life movement" for three decades now examine the message from President Reagan printed in 1993 in *Human Life Review* on the eve of the twentieth anniversary of *Roe v. Wade*. President Reagan stated, "Despite the formidable obstacles before us, we must not lose heart. This is not the first time our country has been divided by a Supreme Court decision that denied the value of certain human lives. The *Dred Scott* decision of 1857 was not overturned in a day, or a year, or even a decade. At first, only a minority of Americans recognized and deplored the moral crisis brought about by denying the full humanity of our black brothers and sisters; but that minority persisted in their vision and finally prevailed. They did it by appealing to the hearts and minds of their countrymen, to the truth of human dignity under God. From their example, we know that respect for the sacred value of human life is too deeply engrained in the hearts of our people to remain forever suppressed. But the great majority of the American people have not yet made their voices heard, and we cannot expect them to—any more than the public voice arose against slavery—until the issue is clearly framed and presented."

Not only does that message prove the "faith" in the majority that has been the bedrock premise upon which all Christian political leadership has stood but it reveals something else: ignorance of historical facts.

Look again at what he said about the Supreme Court's *Dred Scott* decision. He said, "*Dred Scott* was not overturned in...even a decade..."

In fact, in little more than three years after *Dred Scott* this nation was thrown into a terrible war that cost more Americans their lives than any war in American history, and that war overturned *Dred Scott* long before a decade had passed.

But according to President Reagan, it took more than a "decade" to overturn *Dred Scott*. And the wrongful court decision was overturned by a "...persistent minority...appealing to the hearts and minds of their countrymen, to the truth of human dignity under God."

Do you not find it curious at best that a sitting President would take the position that *Dred Scott* was overturned by a minority appealing to the "hearts and minds" of the majority of the American people when in fact *Dred Scott* had been overturned by force of arms carried out by a minority composed of fighting men who literally colored many creeks and rivers on the eastern seaboard of this nation red with human blood?

The most bizarre part of the story of Ronald Reagan is the "pride" the *Human Life Review* and indeed the entire "pro-life movement" had in President Ronald Reagan. An explanation for this support can be found in the obsession the "pro-life movement" has had in a solution dependent upon appealing to the hearts and minds of the majority. President Ronald Reagan over and over again parroted that same theme and the pro-life movement supported him in spite of the fact that he appointed two of the people who today comprise the majority on the Supreme Court that continues to support *Roe v. Wade* in every decision brought before it.

Ronald Reagan established the formula that every succeeding Republican, Christian President followed. They gave lip service to protecting the lives of unborn children but did literally nothing to actually protect them and in fact tended to appoint people to the Supreme Court of the USA that would ensure the Supreme Court would not overturn *Roe v. Wade*. President George W. Bush, like his Republican President father, while giving lip service to opposing abortion, has not one unborn living baby to show for his "opposition" to abortion.

Since *Roe v. Wade* ushered in the holocaust the politicians supported by the "pro-life movement" have succeeded in redefining history and Holy Scripture itself so that no "solution" could be contemplated by the "Christian pro-life movement" except those that relied on an appeal to the hearts and minds of the majority.

This magazine offers some evidence that period is drawing to a close. For every person who supports us the evidence continues to grow until, if God will send us the support, we will see a ground swell in this nation that will alert the American people to the fact that restoration events are finally in the offing.
